

# Revelation Review

## Chapter 1

The 1<sup>st</sup> Century Christians were suffering horrible persecution by the Romans and even by unbelieving Jews. It was about to get worse! Many were wondering who was really in control. Should they quit? They needed a revelation from God.

These Christians were familiar with the Old Testament revelations of Isaiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, Zechariah, etc. God used variations of many of the same symbols He used in their prophecies when He gave this revelation to John.

These 1<sup>st</sup> Century Christians were also familiar with Jewish history. They knew how God worked through the course of that history. This revelation makes references to past world empires. It reminds all Christians that God is still in control regardless who sits on an earthly throne.

God gave this revelation to Jesus, who gave it to an angel, who showed it to John, who sent it to the seven churches of Asia to assure them (*and us*) that **We Win In The End!**

The Throne Room of God!



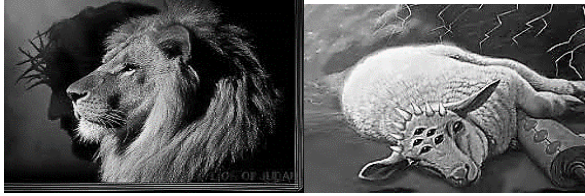
John was called to “*Come up hither*”. He saw God on His throne! The rainbow over His throne symbolized He is a promise keeping God. He will keep His promises to Christians!

## Chapter 5

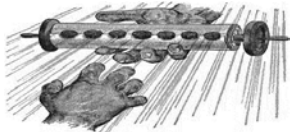
### The Lion of Judah! The Lamb of God!

## Chapter 7

### 144,000 Sealed!



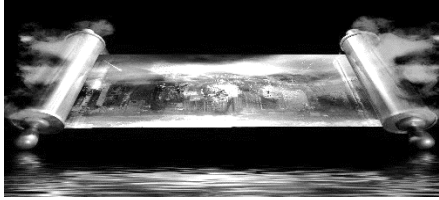
Before the Seventh Seal is opened, God reveals that only His people can be saved. John heard the number of the saved! It was 144,000 (*Twelve thousand from each of the twelve tribes*). Upon close inspection of the list of the tribes, we see that Joseph and Levi are listed. The tribe of Levi was not numbered with the twelve and Joseph is not a tribe at all!

We also see that the tribes of Dan and Ephraim are missing.

This list shows two things: 1) The 144,000 number is not to be taken literally ; 2) There are some that will be "lost". Only the saved can be sealed! When John turns around he doesn't see 144,000, he sees a great number that no man could number from ALL nations, not just Jews! This answers who and how many will be saved! If we are sealed, **We Win In The End!**

# Chapters 8 & 9

## The Seventh Seal Opened & The Sounding of Six of the Seven Trumpets!



When the Seventh Seal was opened there was silence in heaven for ½ an hour. There has been a lot of “noise” and “activity” to this point. This could simply be a pause in the action to prepare the readers for the next phase of activity. It could also be symbolic of the peace and rest the saved, sealed, suffering, saints will enjoy in heaven. The first Six Seals prophesied judgment upon non-believers, but the Seventh Seal was reserved to give hope to the sealed! The Seven Trumpets offer the same message as the Seals. The first Six Trumpets prophesied judgment upon non-believers.

1. **1/3 Part of Trees** - Judgment on People
2. **1/3 Part of Sea** - Judgment on Nations
3. **1/3 Part of Rivers** - Judgment on Communities
4. **1/3 Part of Sun, Moon, & Stars** - Judgment on Rulers / Governments
5. **Bottomless Pit Opened** - Judgment on all those who do not have the seal of God
6. **Army Released From Euphrates River** – Judgment is executed yet they didn’t repent!

Those who don’t repent will be punished, but we who repent of sin know **We Win In The End!**

# Chapter 10

## The Angel & The Little Book!



Before the Seventh Trumpet was sounded. John saw a vision of an angel standing on the sea and the land holding a little book in his hand. The book was open! It was not sealed! It was to be shared with the whole world!

John was told that there would be “*time no longer*”. He was told that in the days of the Seventh Angel sounding, the “*mystery of God should be finished*”. Then John was told to eat the little book! # Chapter 11

He was given a ruler to measure the “*temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship therein*”. John was told not to measure the court outside the temple because the “*Gentiles*” would be allowed to “*tread under foot*” there for 42 months.

The 3 ½ Years; 42 Months; 1,260 Days; and the “*Time, Times, and ½ Time*” that repeatedly occur are all the same period. Since it is ½ of Seven (*which represents completeness*), this period is “*incomplete*” or limited. If Christians will be patient and endure, they will not suffer forever. Their suffering is temporary.

These Two Witnesses “*are the Two Olive Trees and the Two Candlesticks standing before God*”. This takes the reader to Zechariah Chapter 4 where the Olive Trees and Candlesticks are symbols of the Spirit of God. They are the “*Anointed Ones*”!

Some believe the Two Witnesses are Moses and Elijah since they did the same miracles that Moses and Elijah did, but these are not literal men. These are symbols indicating that the people of God need to preach the Word of God even though they will be killed for it! The people of God are the “*anointed ones*” that must preach the Word, and they can rest assured they will be saved in the end.

The Seventh Trumpet sounded revealing that the wicked would be destroyed and the servants of God will be rewarded. Heaven will surely be worth it all because **We Win In The End!**

# Chapter 12

## The Woman; The Dragon; & The Man Child!



The First Century Christians were wondering why they were suffering! This is the reason! The Dragon, Satan, wants to destroy Jesus Christ and all who follow Him. When Satan was defeated in his attempt to destroy Christ, he desperately tried to destroy His Church, but she was preserved. The gates of hell will never destroy her (Matthew 16:18)! # Chapter 13

## The Beast & The False Prophet



To make war with the saints, the Dragon, Satan, gave power to a “Beast”. This beast had qualities of a Leopard, Bear, and Lion which is exactly the qualities of three of the four beasts described in Daniel Chapter 7! The beasts in Daniel represented the World Empires of history. The Babylonian Empire is represented by the Lion. The Medo-Persian Empire is represented by the Bear, and the Grecian Empire is represented by the leopard. The fourth beast of Daniel was “*dreadful and terrible*”! He represents the Roman Empire. Many believe the fourth beast of Daniel Chapter 7 is the Beast of Revelation Chapter 13. Others believe the Beast of Revelation is a particular Emperor of the Roman Empire, perhaps Nero. Since “*the number of his name*” is 666 they count it like this:

“*Nero Caesar*” in the Hebrew alphabet is **נרון קסר** NRON QSR

**N = 50 ; R = 200 ; O = 6 ; N = 50      Q = 100 ; S = 60 ; R = 200      = 666**

Some manuscripts say the number is not 666, but 616. If you drop the last “N” off NRON, it will take away 50 and the numbers add up to 616.

Those that reject this view simply acknowledge the fact that three “Sevens”- 777 is the Perfect Number for God and three “Sixes” - 666 is the Number for all that is Evil and against God.

Still others believe the “Beast” to be the Papacy of the Catholic Church that so many have been willing to bow down to and worship as “*The Holy Father*”.

The False Prophet of this chapter is a lamb (*just as Christ is represented by a lamb*), yet he speaks as a Dragon. This is false doctrine! Some say it is the false doctrine of Emperor Worship which directly affected the First Century Christians. If they didn’t worship the Emperor, they would be killed. Others believe it is the false doctrine of Catholicism which would spring from the Roman system and pervert Christianity.

Then there are those that believe the beast is some future “*Antichrist*” that will arise and deceive the world into worshiping him. He will be supported by a false religion that will urge everyone to give him their devotion and reverence.

Regardless of the specific meaning of The Beast & The False Prophet, we know they will not win in the end! God is in complete control! His followers are under His ultimate protection! If we follow Him, we can rest assured that **We Win In The End!**

# Chapter 14

## The Lamb Returns!



The Lamb of God, Jesus Christ, comes with His sealed and saved people! He pronounces judgment against “*Babylon*” and those who “*worship the beast*”.

This is GOOD NEWS for the Christians that have been suffering at the hands of the wicked. Christians receive great comfort and assurance when they hear:

***The “One Is” is the current World Empire during the time John wrote the Revelation which is Rome.***

- 6) Roman Empire

***The other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space***

- 7) The Western Roman Empire In 476 AD the Western Empire fell. It lasted a short period.

***And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition.***

- 8) Holy Roman Empire - 800 AD – 1806 AD

If not Rome, perhaps she is a particular Emperor of Rome. This is how some identify her:

Vespasian carried on Nero’s work to destroy Jerusalem therefore he represents the “deadly wound was healed”.***

Some believe that John wrote the Revelation later in the First Century thus Domitian, a later Emperor, would be the Beast of the Chapter.

There are many who think the “*Harlot*” and her “*Beast*” is still yet to come. It is unlikely God gave First Century Christians assurance by telling them about someone who will arrive thousands of years later, but if a “*Harlot*” like person arises on the world scene in our future, we can be assured that they, like all world leaders who refuse Christ and persecute His followers, will be judged by God.
