

# TIME

Each year at this time we set our clocks back one hour because “*Daylight Savings Time*” ends. In the spring we set our clocks ahead to save some daylight!

I love lots of daylight! Getting dark at 8:30 pm is a lot better for me than getting dark at 5:00 pm. It seems like I have more time! The truth is there are still 24 hours in the day.

We may have set up a way to measure the time, but God set up time itself. Solomon wisely observed that there was a time for everything done under heaven (**Ecclesiastes 3:1:8**).

There are lots of things we can do with our time, but we cannot save it. We can only spend it! Once that second, minute, hour, day, week, month, year, decade, is gone, it is gone! How am I spending my time?

God tells us to make the most use of our time. We live in uncertain times when bad things are happening all around us (**Ephesians 5:16**). We should take advantage of every opportunity to do good!

Solomon also observed that wise folks spend their time serving God. This is what he wrote in **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14** “*Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.*”

**Revelation 10:6** tells us that time will stop. There will be time no longer! This means we will not be “*Springing our clocks forward in the Spring*” or “*Falling back in the Fall*”. We will be in a place called “*eternity*” where there are no clocks or calendars.

What will we be doing in eternity? That totally depends upon what we are doing with the time God has given us now!
