This faith moves us to be **THANKFUL** for the love we enjoy in Christ Jesus and the hope we have in heaven.

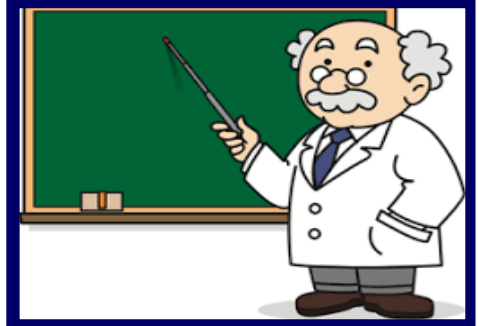
This is based on the **TRUTH**, not simply "positive thinking" or a "pie in the sky" wishful thinking! We know it is right!

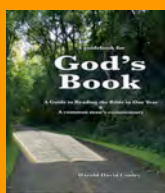

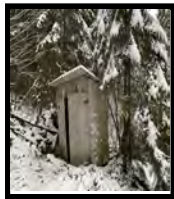
